tune: "I'm Bringing Home a Baby Bumblebee"

Start by catching a bee in cupped hands.

I'm bringing home a baby bumblebee
Won't my Mommy be so proud of me
Oh I'm bringing home a baby bumblebee
Buzz buzz buzz buzz buzz! *(let bee fly away!)*

2. dinosaur – won't my mommy hide behind the door!
3. crocodile – won't my mommy wear a great big smile!
4. grizzly bear – won't my mommy tear out all her hair!
5. Bringing home a great big pot of love, so much bigger than the sky above
Oh I'm bringing home a great big pot of love – hug, hug, kiss, kiss, kiss!

For verse #5 I ask the children what their mommy would like for a present. For each item, we put our arms in a circle in front of us – "the pot" – and put everything in. When it's full, sing the verse! You could make a book of the different animals, and what mommy might look like reacting to the animal, according to the song! Good practice with rhyming, too!
