## Skip to My Lou

This dance may take some practice – great for older four year olds and K-2's. Teach it one segment at a time. The directions are in the music.

Skip skip skip to my lou Skip skip skip to my lou Skip skip skip to my lou Skip to my lou my darling.

- V.2 Lost my partner, what'll I do?
- V.3 I'll find another one, how 'bout you?
- V.4 Circle with your partner, skip to my lou.
  - Verse 1: Skip in a circle.
  - Verse 2: Pat knees, clap hands, hands up and out, questioningly on underlined beats: Lost my partner, what'll I do?
  - Verse 3: Find a new partner, hold two hand
  - Verse 4: Swing your partner by going around in a circle

## Repeat the entire dance.

In the recording, I give fewer instructions with each repetition of the patterns that make up the sequence. The final time through it's just the dance. I walking through the dance BEFORE turning on the music. Once mastered, it just may become a favorite dance!
