Somebody's Waiting for Me

As I looked into your eyes, I beheld with glad surprise
There is somebody waiting for me. (change directions)
There is somebody waiting, there is somebody waiting
There is somebody waiting for me.

Choose two, leave the others, choose two, leave the others Choose two, leave the others for me.

Swing one, leave the others, swing one, leave the others Swing one, leave the others for me.

This is the most complicated dance on this cd – and best for children 5 and older. Once they understand the sequence, they will really enjoy it. Walk it through before trying it with the music...more than once, depending on the age of the children.

Formation: A large outer circle and small inner circle:

- 1. To begin, put just two children in the inner circle. It's less confusing. The outer and inner circles should walk in opposite directions, changing directions in the middle of the verse as indicated.
- 2. Stop so that the children in the middle can come out and choose 2 people from the outside circle to bring into the middle with them. Outer circle can clap while this is happening. The child who did the choosing now chooses one of the children they brought in to elbow swing with. Are you with me thus far?

Then those who were swinging (couples) QUICKLY join the outer circle, leaving the two new dancers in the inner circle. Start again. I LOVE THIS DANCE!!!!
