Old MacDonald had a farm – EIEIO! And on his farm he had a cow – EIEIO! With a moo moo here, and a moo moo there Here a moo, there a moo, everywhere a moo moo Old MacDonald had a farm – EIEIO!

You know the song – here's how to make it engaging for the child who's got a handle on what sounds the animals make. Sing one verse as you normally would – inviting the child to make the animal's sound with you. When you get to that point in the second verse, blithely sing the WRONG animal sound:

"...and on his farm he had a dog, EIEIO!

With a quack quack here and a quack quack there...."

At some point the child will tell you, "NO! That's not what a dog says!" If you've done it with a smile and a wink, they'll know you're not stupid – just playing with them! Do it again. As the child catches on, they will wait with great anticipation for you to bumble the sound! Have fun!
