Icky Sticky and Ooey Gooey

This delightful rhyming fingerplay helps children HEAR the rhyme. Don't expect most children under 4 to automatically get it – they often will shout out the last verse's answer! Ear training is good practice for this early literacy skill. **Give the kids a hint** – "The word we're looking for will always be a body part."

Oh, Icky Sticky and Ooey Gooey, they went out one day Said Icky Sticky to Ooey Gooey, "Won't you come and play?" So Icky Sticky and Ooey Gooey dug in the sand But Icky Sticky got stuck to Ooey Gooey's – HAND!

Verses: jumped on a bed/HEAD, swam in the sea/KNEE, visited a farm/ARM, got something to eat/FEET, hid behind a boulder/SHOULDER!
