

Partner Dance

Partner won't you dance with me
Clap my hands now, 1 – 2 – 3
One foot out, one foot in
'Round about and back again!

DANCE: Face your partner, hands up with theirs. Clap on "1 – 2 – 3". Hold hands, putting one foot to the side, then back in. Two-hand swing! Then find a new partner!

Partner dancing increases the difficulty level of group dancing. We touch our partner and must do the same moves at the same time. This dance also asks you to change partners.

My house rule is that if someone offers you their hands, the answer is always YES!

Teacher note: If you know that a certain child is unlikely to get picked, YOU pick that child on the first go-around. Then hand them off to their next partner. I never get an objection.
