Leader sings first, children echo.
I was out one night (echo)
Walking my dog (echo)
When I saw an old man (echo)
Sitting on a log (echo)
ALL: He was a Great Big Man!

Start patting the rhythm on your legs to indicate walking. Keep the rhythm going while singing. On the last line, stretch hands out wide to the side.

With each repetition add something that made the man noticeable – spaghetti hair, Lego legs – whatever the children suggest! This is a good song for memory – each addition gets into the line of the man's unusual appearance!
