ACTIVITY SUGGESTIONS: The children should repeat every line after Stephen with the exception of the last one. "We won't stop 'til we find it" - stretch out arm with palm straight up and down. "'Cause it's our pirate duty" make a fist and move arm acros body. "It could be over here" — put one hand above eyes and point with free hand. "It could be over there" put other hand above eyes and point with free hand. "It could be buried deep" — point down with both hands while moving hands down. "It could be anywhere" — point all around with both hands. "We're goin' on a treasure hunt" — put hand above eyes and look around. "And you can come along" — point to someone and motion them towards you.
