Purpose: To transition your kids from the classroom to anywhere you need them to go.

Setting: Large Group.

Materials: Clock Face with Hour and Minute hands.

Activities:

- 1. Begin a discussion about the beginning, middle and ending of each school day.
- Using a clock face with hands, show your children at what point each day it will be time to go.
- 3. During the song, call out individual names to get your children in line or to let them move to their destination.
- During the song, instead of using names, try calling out clothing color or types of clothes.
- 5. Talk about the importance of being ready to go and being on time as opposed to being late.
